3. AIMS AND .
OBJECTS

The Society is a Christian Minority Educational Institution governed by the relevant articles of the Constitution of India dealing with the minority rights.

The Aims and Objects for which the Society is established are as follows:

- To Establish and run schools, colleges, hostels for students irrespective of caste, creed, sex and age.
- b) To take over, conduct the existing institutions with similar objects or akin thereto, and to run any educational institution in furtherance thereof.

The Society is named as "ST. CLARET EDUCATION SOCIETY, CHIMUR" and is being referred to herein after as 'Society' for the sake of brevity.

> I. SPECIAL COMMITTEE

The 'SOCIETY' means "ST. CLARET EDUCATION SOCIETY, CHIMUR"

The 'GOVERNING BODY' shall mean the body formed in the manner provided in Clause [11] of theses Rules and Regulations.

The 'SUPERIOR GENERAL' shall mean the head for the time being of the Claretian Congregation.

The 'PROVINCIAL SUPERIOR' shall mean the head for the time being of the Province of Claretian Congregation to which the Society belongs.

The 'CONGREGATION' means the religious condition of the Sons of the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Warre Mary established by St. Anthony Mary Claret in Vic. Spain on July 16, 1849 and approved by Pope Pious IX on December 22, 1865.

The 'LOCAL SUPERIOR' shall mean a member of the congregation appointed as such by the Provincial Superior to look after the affairs of the registration of the society and to do all other acts and deeds in connection with the same and also to act as the president in the Governing Body meetings in case vacancy arises in the post of the Chairperson due to death or otherwise.

Notice which maintains the gap of prescribed period between the date of receipt of notice and the date of meeting [both dates to be excluded] shall be termed as 'CLEAR NOTICE'.

3. JURISDICTION:

The Jurisdiction of the Society will be whole of India.

4. FINANCIAL YEAR:

The Financial Year of the Society shall start with effect from 1st day of April of the each year and shall conclude on the 31st day of March of the ensuing year.

ENROLMENT OF i) MEMBERS: The person who -

- a) Is a professed member of the Congregation.
- b) Who has completed his age of 21 years.
- c) Who is an Indian citizen.
- d) Who is mentally fit.
- e) Who has not been declared insolvent, and
- f) Who has not been convicted for any crime by the court of law may become the member of the society.
- ii) The persons possessing the said qualifications may apply in writing to the Governing Body for getting enrolled as member of the Society. The Governing Body in its duly held meeting may accept the said person as member, however, mere possession of the required qualification will not compel the Governing Body to accept the membership of the said person and the Governing Body's decision in that regard shall be final and conclusive.

CATEGORIES OF MEMBERS:

A. FOUNDER MEMBERS The persons who have founded this society by making all sort of efforts and who have subscribed their signatures to the Memorandum of Association shall be called the FOUNDER MEMBERS of the Society. Their Membership shall tast for their lifetime unless the same comes to an end for the reasons mentioned in clause [7] below.

B. LIFE MEMBER

Any person eligible to become member of the society, who pays an amount of Rs. 1,000½ to the society and who has been enrolled as Life Member of the Society will be the Life Member of the Society and his membership will last for his lifetime unless the same is terminated in accordance with the provisions under clause [7] in these rules and regulations.

Any person eligible to become member of the society who pays an amount of Rs. 100/ to the society and who has been enrolled as General Member of the Society will be the General Member of the Society. His membership will last till the end of twelve months from the date of the payment of subscription and his failure to deposit the subscription before the expiry of his membership will automatically bring to an end his membership and there shall be no need to pass any separate resolution for the same. However, such person shall be eligible to become member of the society afresh

D. EX-OFFICIO MEMBER

The Provincial Superior and the Local Superior shall be the exofficio members of the society. The persons in the said offices shall remain members of the society till they continue in their respective offices.

7. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

The membership of the member may come to an end in the following manner:

A. TERMINATION BY THE GOVERNING

The Governing Body may terminate the membership of any member who is acting against the interest of the society or is giving go-by to the ethics of the society. 8. GENERAL BODY, ITS POWERS AND FUNCTIONS :

The GENERAL BODY shall be the supreme authority of the Society. In addition to those functions which are mentioned specifically in the forthcoming paras, it shall have all powers and it may perform all those functions which it should perform in furtherance of the objects of the society and which are not within the purview of the Governing Body of the Society.

9. MEETING OF GENERAL BODY: The General Body may meet in the (i) Annual General Meeting and (ii) Special General Meeting.

i) ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING General Body of the Society shall meet at least once in the year on the date, at the venue and at the time fixed by the Governing Body. Business to be transacted in the Annual General Meeting shall be

- a) To confirm the minutes of the last meeting.
- To consider and adopt the report of the Governing Body on its working during the preceding year.
- To consider and approve the audited statements of accounts for preceding year.
- d) To appoint/re-appoint the auditors.
- To elect the office bearers/members of the Governing Body of the Society.
- f) To transact such other business as demanded by the members of the General Body handed over to the Secretary 7 days in advance to the date of meeting and approved by the Chairman for consideration. Fifteen day's clear notice shall have to be given for holding Annual General Meeting.

The Special General Meeting of the Society may be held to consider the matters of urgent and/or important nature after delivery of notice 3 days in advance to be issued by the Secretary on behalf of and at the instance of the Governing Body or on requisition by at least 3 members of the Governing Body. In case of receipt of such requisition, the Secretary shall have to issue notice within 2 days calling the meeting within 7 days from the date of receipt of requisition and telegraphic notice may be issued as emergent mode.

C. SECRETARY

He shall have to maintain all records, books etc. including Proceeding book/minute book concerning the meetings of the Governing Body and other records up to date. 16. QUORUM AND NOTICE : 2/3rd members shall form quorum for meetings of the Governing Body.

If the quorum is not available at the scheduled time of meeting, the meeting will be adjourned for 30 minutes. Inspite of adjournment, if the quorum is not available, them the members present shall form the quorum provided that at least 3 members should attend the meeting. - ii) Unless provided otherwise, the resolutions may be eassed by simple majority.

- d) To carry out the office duties and the functions of the trustees, managers and administrators, either solely or jointly with others or in respect of any gifts, donations, trusts, foundations or property, whether vested in the Society or otherwise notwithstanding that carrying out of such trusts may involve the exercise of powers not specifically mentioned herein.
- To borrow, lend or receive money or deposits upon such terms and with or without involving the present or future assets/property of the society as the Governing Body deems fit.
- f) To negotiate and enter into an agreement with any organisation including Government, Sate, University, Municipality, Person, Body, Association, which may deem beneficial and conducive to any objectives of the Society.
- g) To deposit money in the scheduled bank either in saving or current accounts, fixed deposits or accounts of any other description and to withdraw such money from time to time on such terms and in such manner as the Governing Body may
- h) To carry on any activity of manufacturing or non-manufacturing kind, which may deem beneficial or conducive to any of the objectives of the society and either alone or in conjunction with others and as trustees or agents otherwise and on such terms as the Governing Body may deem fit.
- i) To draw, endorse, discount and in general deal with bills of exchange, bills of load, railway receipts, registered or insured letters or parcels, postal receipts, savings certificates, dock warrants, bonds, debentures, government/municipal or port trust loan notes, stock and other negotiable, commercial or transferable instruments or securities.
 - To provide for the maintenance and accommodation of the members in view of their services and persons employed by or connected with the society irrespective of caste or creed but subject to the approval of the Governing Body by establishing/contributing to provident and other beneficial funds, and by giving pension or otherwise as the Governing Body may deem fit.

To establish, maintain, close down branches or representations of the society at such places in India and on such terms as the Governing Body may from time to time deems necessary or expedient.

The Special Committee may be formed by the covering Body if need arises. It shall not be consisting of more than members out of which, at least one shall be the member of the Governing Body. The Governing Body shall make decision as to who will head the said committee, how it shall work and what shall be its powers and duties. MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS :

Entire funds of the society excepting that is required for the routine expenses shall have to be deposited in the society's bank account. The Society's funds shall have to be applied strictly in accordance with the Rules/Regulations and the concerned legal provisions. However, if the Governing Body deems fit or necessary, it may deposit the portion of the excess funds available with it in nay of the Bank or company fixed deposits or bonds or in units in mutual funds for short term or long term.

24 PURCHASE AND OF SALE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY:

The Society may purchase, sell or take on lease immovable property when proposal to that effect comes before the Governing Body and is converted in resolution. On such resolution, the following conditions shall be followed at the time of purchase/sale or lease of the immovable property i.e.

- All such transactions shall be made strictly in the name of the a) Society.
- No property shall be sold, purchased, leased or obtained on lease unless there in genuine cause for the same.

25. BANK ACCOUNT : A.

The Society shall have its bank account with the Scheduled Bank only which is approved by the Governing Body and the same shall be opened in the name of the society only. This account will be operated with signatures of any two amongst the President, Secretary or Treasurer as is decided in the Governing Body Meeting.

B. Except as provided in these rules and regulations, the entire funds of the society shall have to be deposited in the society's bank account excepting the expenditures of the routine nature, all expenditures shall have to be made through the crossed cheques only.

26. REGISTER OF MEMBERS:

The Society shall maintain the register of members in accordance with the provisions of the Societies Registration Ast, 1860 wherein, the details of the members shall be recorded in the given form. Any change as to the address and/or other particulars about the members immediately on occurrence should be conveyed to the Governing Body by the concerned members and the Governing Body shall be liable to make the suitable corrections in the register with immediate effect.

27. AMENDMENT IN A. RULES AND, REGULATIONS:

Any Rules/regulations of the society may be amended by passing resolution by 3/4th majority in the General Body Meeting of the Society.

B. Name and object of the society may be amended in accordance with the provisions under the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

28. DISSOLUTION:

The society may be dissolved only through the resolution passed by at least 3/5th members present and voting in the General Body Meeting called for the said purpose only as per provisions under Section 13 and 14 of The Societies Registration Act, 1860.

29. ARBITRATION:

The decision of the Governing Body of the Society and of the Provincial Superior will be final in the matters of dispute.
